Robert Wayne Crotchett, 78, died at 12:57 a.m., Thursday, October 29, 2009 at his residence after a period of declining health. He was born in Rockbridge, Il, on Aug. 1, 1931, one of seven children born to the late Arnold B. and Mabel Evelyn (Tucker) Crotchett. Bob was raised in the Kane vicinity, and graduated from the Kane High School. After serving his country with the U.S. Army during the Korean War, he returned home and began working at the Duncan Foundry for a short time. He retired in 1982 from Laclede Steel in Alton where he had been employed as a supervisor in teh Billet yard. He married the former Gail Gilworth on July 1, 1955 at the Bethel Baptist Church in rural Jerseyville, and together they have shared 54 years together. In his spare time, Bob enjoyed being outdoors, whether it was hunting or fishing. He enjoyed playing cards, and camping with his favorite spot being Carlyle Lake. After retirement, he also enjoyed spending the afternoons with his wife and friends at various locations in town, and was a member of the Elks Lodge and American Legion both of Jerseyville.
