John Howard Mendenhall Sr., 91, passed away at 12:50 p.m. on Monday, November 16, 2009 at Christian Hospital North East, in St. Louis, MO.

He was born on October 27, 1918 in Chicago Heights, IL, son of the late John Franklin & Ethel (Evans) Mendenhall.

He married Alice L. (Reid) in Chicago, IL on June 20, 1942. She survives.

Howard received a B.S. in metallurgical engineering from the University of Illinois. He was employed at Olin Brass as a metallurgical engineer for over 40 years, being a brass alloys expert, retiring in 1985.
