James Arthur Cannon passed from his earthly home to a celestial reunion with many relatives and friends on January 15, 2010. He was born May 13, 1915, son of William Arthur and Mariemma (Kremer) Cannon in Alton.

He attended Alton schools, graduating from Alton High School in June 1933. He worked at various jobs in the Alton area as well as three years in Chicago. In January 1942, he enlisted in the military service where he remained until October 1945. He became an aerial navigator First Lieutenant involved in the delivery of aircraft to England, North Africa, and India.
