Marjorie Ann Johnson, 75, died at 11:27 p.m. Thursday, January 14, 2010 at Boyd Memorial Hospital in Carrollton, IL. Born October 12, 1934 in Alton, she was the daughter of Vernon E. and Margaret (Walker) Dehner Sr.

She was a Personnel Officer for Mercantile Bank for many years, retiring in December 1984. She was very involved with Elm Street Presbyterian Church in Alton where she had been a member since 1947.
