Charles William Eugene Simmons, 86, died at 3:15 p.m. Friday, February 12, 2010 at his residence.

He was born November 17, 1923 in Carryville, Arkansas the son of William and Nellie (Smith) Simmons.

Charles had three older brothers, three older sisters, three younger brothers, one younger sister and a twin sister. He served in the US Army during WWII. After the war he worked at Laclede Steel in Alton and was also a self-employed home builder.
