Josephine Joan Trosley, 88, passed away Sunday, April 11, 2010 at Fort Madison Community Hospital in Fort Madison, Iowa.

She was born March 2, 1922 in Alton to Antonio and Gaetana (Albani) Ramondi.

Her marriage to Joseph Anthony Trosley was on Jan. 23, 1945 at Camp Gordon, Ga. He preceded her in death Sept. 19, 1989.

Josephine lived in Alton until her late teens, when her family moved to Wood River, where she and her husband remained and raised their family. In 2006, she joined her son, Father Tony Trosley, in Nauvoo. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents; a son, Raymond T. Trosley on Jan. 29, 2010; and a sister, Catherine DeSalvo.
