Robert (Bob) W. Schulz Sr., 95, born on September 9, 1914, son of Bernard C & Mary (Hauck) Schulz, passed away at his home in Alton on Wednesday, May 26, 2010.

Bob graduated from Marquette Catholic High School in 1932 and married Stella Haas on August 26, 1940 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Alton. Stella preceded him in death on December 8, 2001.
