

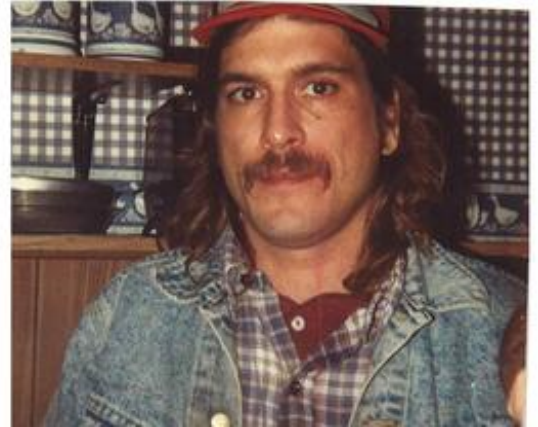
William Lloyd "Rebel" Kessinger

William Lloyd "Rebel" Kessinger, 51, died at 3:01 p.m. on Thursday, May 27, 2010 at his home in rural Jersey County after a prolonged battle with lung cancer.
