Jack R. Jameson died at 1:30 a.m., Friday, July 23, 2010, his 78th birthday, after a brave battle with cancer.

He was born in Hannibal, Mo. on July 23, 1932, the son of the late Roy "Pun" and Mabel (Morgan) Jameson.



Jack was a U.S. Army Korean War veteran, and was a resident of California for many years until moving to Jersey County in 1975. While in California, Jack owned and operated Pinto Floor Covering in Redwood City, Ca. While in Jerseyville, he was able to enjoy his retirement, and was a active member of the Jerseyville Elks Lodge #954 and the First Assembly of God. He married the former Barbara J.
