



Dorris Dooley

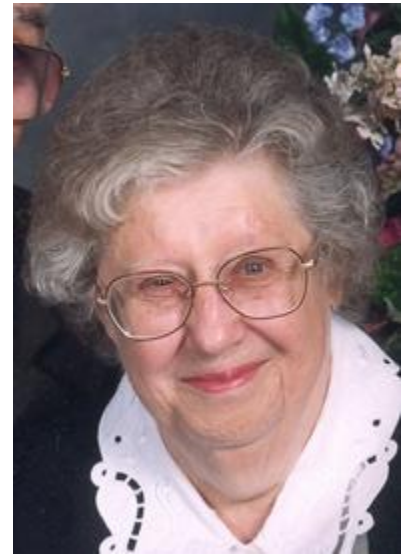
