Elmer E. Harbour, 94, passed away at 1 p.m. Tuesday, November 9, 2010 at home. He was born Nov. 15, 1915 in Wood River to Claudius Wayne Harbour (who died at the early age of 35) and Lena Christine (Fingerhut) Harbour. Elmer worked in rim fire loading for Olin Corp. until his retirement Jan. 1, 1978. He was a member of the Wood River Masonic Lodge for over 50 years, and a member of St. Paul United Methodist Church in Rosewood Heights for many years.
