Joseph “Joe” S. Mormino, 89, died Thursday, December 2, 2010 at 3:10 p.m. at Saint Anthony’s Health Center in Alton. He was born February 5, 1921 in Napoleonville, Louisiana the son of Charles and Rosa Dipasquale Mormino.

On July 2, 1947 at St. Barbara’s Catholic Church in Batchtown, IL he married Frances Sievers and she survives. He was a WWII veteran serving with the U.S. Army 324th Infantry Regiment , 44th Division. He retired after 20 years from the Alton Fire Department.
