Silvio “Dud” L. Finn, age 96, passed away, at 3:25 p.m. Friday, December 17, 2010 at West County Care Center in Ballwin, MO.

He was born in Hermansville, MI on March 12, 1914, son of the late Giuseppe & Maria (Diquigiovanni) Fin.

He married Isabelle A. (Sharpe) on May 16, 1953 in Gillespie, IL. She passed away November 25, 1991.

Dud was a graduate of Rankin Tech School in St. Louis, MO. He served the U. S. Army from 1943-1945 in 79th Infantry and 813th Tank Destroyer divisions in Europe during WWII.
