Alison Gwynne Jones, 46, died at 1:21 pm on Tuesday, February 22, 2011 at St. Louis University in St. Louis, MO.

She was born on February 25, 1964 in San Francisco, CA, the daughter of Verda (Clauseen) Jones and the late J. Alan Jones.

Alison attended schools in Oregon, Idaho and Washington, graduating from Blaine, WA High School in 1982. In 1983 she moved to Seldovia, Alaska, where she lived for the next 13 years.
