


Leroy LaPelle

Leroy J. LaPelle, 95, died at 1:35 p.m. Thursday, March 31, 2011 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born October 4, 1915 in Beardstown, IL, he was the son of Roy and Anna (Tunker) LaPelle.
