Robert H. "Bob" Allison, 90, passed away at 3:05am on Thursday, June 9, 2011, at his residence. He was born on January 23, 1921, in Bismarck, Illinois the son of the late Franklin Valentine and Pearl (Taylor) Allison. He married the former Mildred Marie Winn on January 1, 1943, in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida and she survives. He was an founding member of the Moro Improvement Association, Moro Water and Sewer District, a former longtime member of the Edwardsville Moose Lodge and a member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen. He spent 22 of his retirement winters in St. Petersburg, Florida with his wife of 68 years. He was an avid gardener, collector of unusual items, a dedicated mushroom hunter, and a classically trained violinist.
