Calvin D. "Denny" Stine, 80, passed away with his loving family by his side at 6:59 p. m. Friday, June 17, 2011 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born September 10, 1930 in Evansville, IN, he was the son of Albert Dennis and Floy (Funk) Stine.

Denny graduated from Alton High School in June 1948. He enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1948 and served for four years. He then attended and graduated from Shurtleff College in 1956 with a degree in business. He worked for Laclede Steel in both Alton and St. Louis and retired in 1991 after 35 years of service. Denny was baptized and confirmed at Messiah Lutheran Church in Alton in January of 1959. On April 12, 1958, he married the former Carolyn Beuttel in Alton. She survives.
