Base in San Diego, California. Joe then served in the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre at Bauganville and Guam. Total time served in the military was 3 years, 2 months and 13 days. Joe was wounded on Guam and was awarded the Purple Heart, he was then discharged on October 17, 1945.
