Gladys Marie Drainer, 83, died at 2:45 p.m., Friday, November 18, 2011 at Memorial Medical Center in Springfield. She was born in Otterville on Sept. 17, 1928, the last surviving of six children born to the late Lester & Blanche (Price) Cope.She married Marvin G. Drainer on Jan. 20, 1945 at the St. Mary's Catholic Church in Fieldon, and during their 57 years of marriage they raised seven children, and together as a family operated their family farm near Otterville for



many years. Marvin passed away on Feb. 21, 2002. Gladys had a passion for Otterville, and instrumental in the formation of the Otter Creek Historical Society which was formed in December of 1998, and secured the Hamilton Primary School on the National Register in August of 1998. She served in many capacities throughout her life, presently serving as President of the Otter Creek Historical Society, served as an Jersey County Election Judge, served as a trustee for Otter Creek Township, and was currently serving on the Otter Creek Township Cemetery Board of Trustees on top of being a huge St. Louis Cardinals Fan. For 28 years, Gladys has served on the Hamilton Primary School Festival Board, ensuring that the school does not get forgotten, and serving as a reason for past & present members of the Otterville community to gather and reminence.
