Angelo Sperino, 69, formerly of Collinsville, died at 1:50 a.m., Thursday, March 1, 2012 at Jerseyville Manor Nursing Home. He was born in East St. Louis on Oct. 20, 1942, one of four children born to the late Angelo & Regina Anna (Hammon) Sperino. Angelo graduated in 1961 from Collinsville High School, and served with the U.S. Army during the Vietnam era.
