Dale W. Favre, 70, passed away at 4:16 pm on Monday, March 12, 2012 at Barnes Jewish Hospital with his family by his side.

He was born on March 15, 1941 in Alton, IL, the son of Albert and Theresa Favre, who preceded him in death.

He married Cathy (Werts) Burk on November 17, 1984 in Bethalto. She survives.



Dale was a graduate of Civic Memorial High School and proudly served his country in the US Marine Corp from 1959 to 1963. He played the trumpet in the Marine Corps Band. After honorably serving his country he served the Village of Bethalto as a Police Officer retiring in 1986 at the rank of Sergeant. Dale was a member of the First Baptist Church of Bethalto, where he served as head of the Security Team. He spent his life serving and protecting others.
