



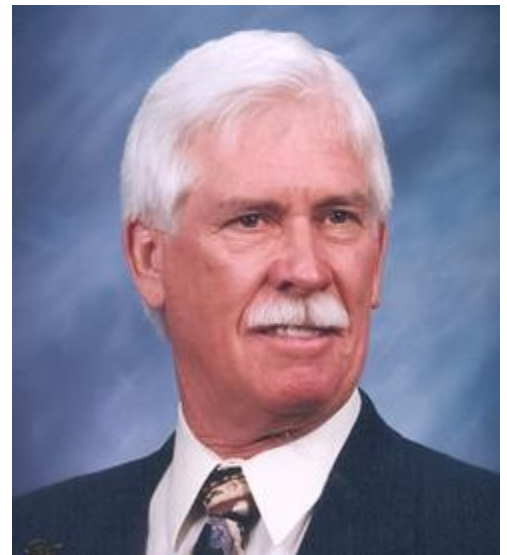
# **Dr. William F. Dilley**
