Harry Stockton "Dutch" Goheen Jr., 70, died at 3:27 p.m., Thursday, November 8, 2012 at Jersey Community Hospital after a brief battle with multiple myeloma.

He was born in Newbern on Oct. 19, 1942, the second of five children born to the late Harry Stockton & Verna (Miller) Goheen Sr.

He graduated in 1962 from Jersey Community High School in Jerseyville, and was well known and respected in the auction community, where he made a career out of buying and selling.
