



Raymond Robbins

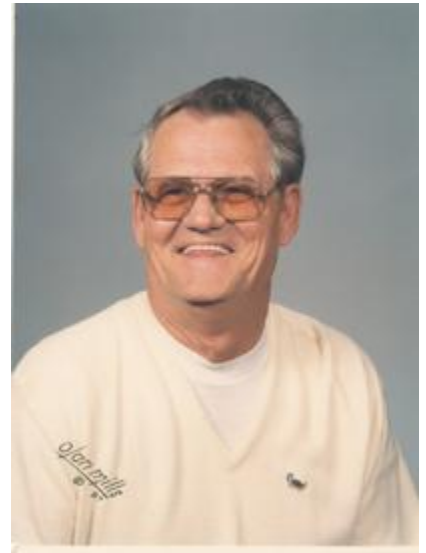
