



Charles (Chuck) E. Hatton Sr

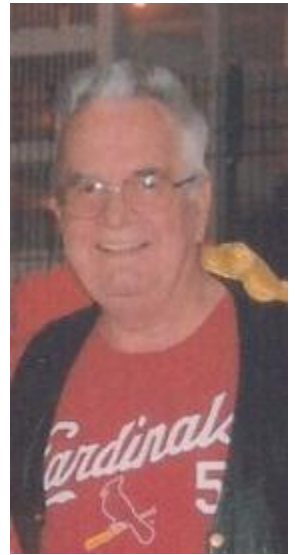
