Martin L. Bugg, 90, died at 1:15 a.m. Monday, August 12, 2013 at Eunice Smith Nursing Home in Alton. Born August 23, 1922 in Clinton, KY, he was the son of Buren L. and Lennie Mae (Wilkins) Bugg.
