Sister Michael Marie Driscoll, O.S.U., aka Elizabeth Ann Driscoll died peacefully at St. Anthony's Hospital in Alton, IL on Sunday, September 29, 2013. She was 83 years old. The daughter of Louis Henry Driscoll Sr. and Grace D. Sanford Driscoll, she was born January 30, 1930 in Laredo, Texas.
