



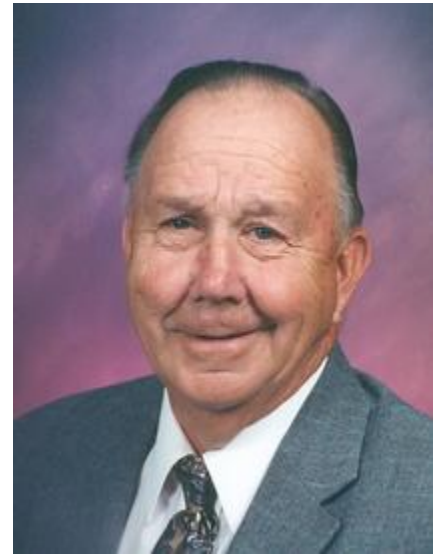
Keith Elliott
