Virginia Lee (Sturgeon) Thomasson, 95, died at 2:36 pm Saturday March 15, 2014 at St. Anthony's Health Center in Alton.

Virginia was born on March 10, 1919 in Hillsboro, Illinois, to Leo and Orlene (Nesbit) Sturgeon.

She attended school in Hillsboro and graduated from Alton High School and Wells Business School. She worked for M.C. Galloway Advertising Company and Sauvage Advertising Company, later at Owens Illinois Glass Company in the accounting department.
