He married Doris M. Muelder on May 28, 1944. She preceded him in death on November 21, 2007.

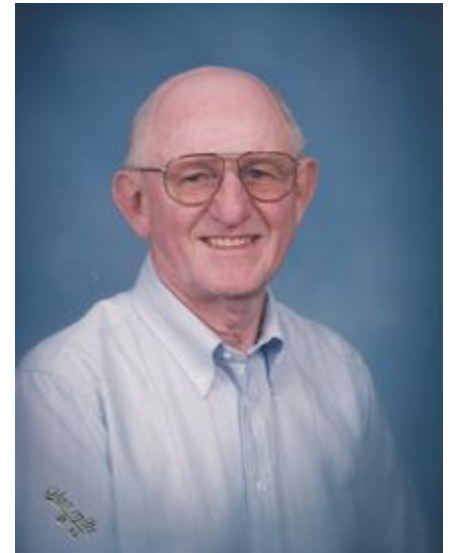
