He attended elementary school in LaCross, KS and graduated high school from Hutchinson High School. He served two years in the army during the Korean War. When he returned from the war, he attended Fort Hays State University and graduated in 1960 with a Bachelor's in Speech and in 1972 with a Master's of Science in Education. He retired from teaching in 1994 after 30 years.
