



Harold Duvall

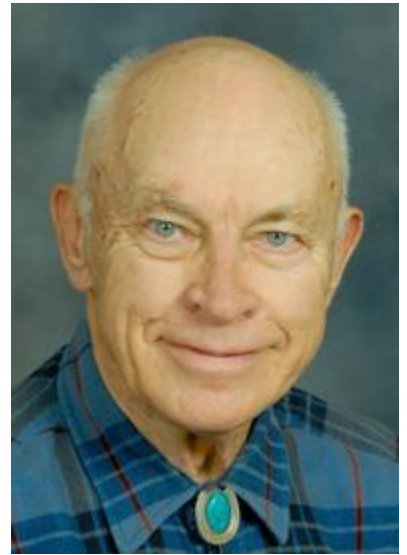
