Marvin F. Leadicker, 91, died at 6:28 a.m. Friday, July 25, 2014 at Robings Manor in Brighton. Born December 25, 1922 in Paducah, KY, he was the son of Virgil and Lou (O'Bryan) Leadicker. He served in the U.S. Navy as a Gunner's Mate Second Class during WWII. He retired as a roller from Laclede Steel in 1982. Over the years he built seven houses for his family.
