Alvin w. Amrein, 88, passed away 7:05 a.m. Saturday, August 2, 2014 at Rosewood Care Center of Alton.

Born March 27, 1926 in St. Charles, MO, he was the son of Alvin A. and Edna B. (Ostmann) Amrein.
