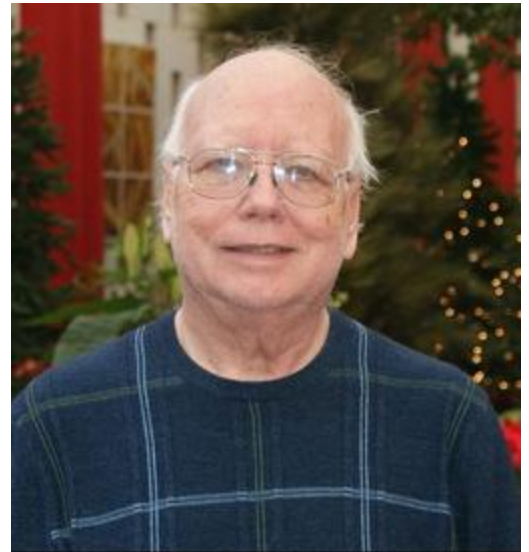


Marvin Saville
