



Jack Chappell

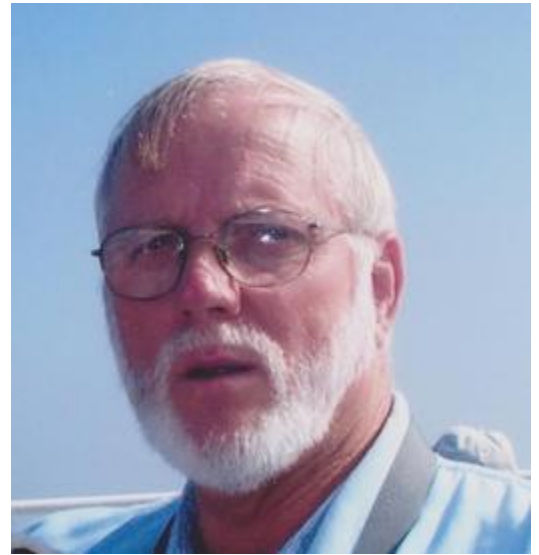

Jack G. Chappell, 76, formerly of East Alton, was pronounced dead at 10:32 p.m. Saturday, October 11, 2014 of injuries sustained in an automobile accident in St. Charles County.

Born in Hamburg on January 10, 1938, he was the son of Arthur Elmer and Loraine (Freesemeyer) Chappell.

Jack had been an engineer manager for McDonnell-Douglas for 37 years before retiring in 1996.
