

## **Gerald Bassett**

Gerald Wayne Bassett, 62, died Sunday, November 9, 2014 at Memorial University Medical Center in Savannah, GA, from complications due to pneumonia, his daughters by his side.

Born on June 11, 1952 in Wood River, he was the son of Merle and Norine Bassett of Rosewood Heights.
