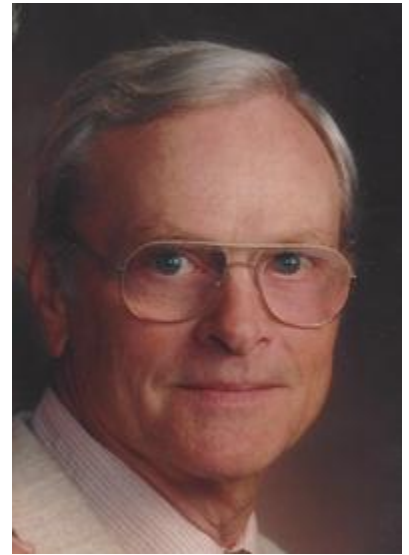

Wayne K. Jennings, 89, passed away 9:40 a.m. Tuesday, November 11, 2014 at Eunice Smith Nursing Home in Alton.
