



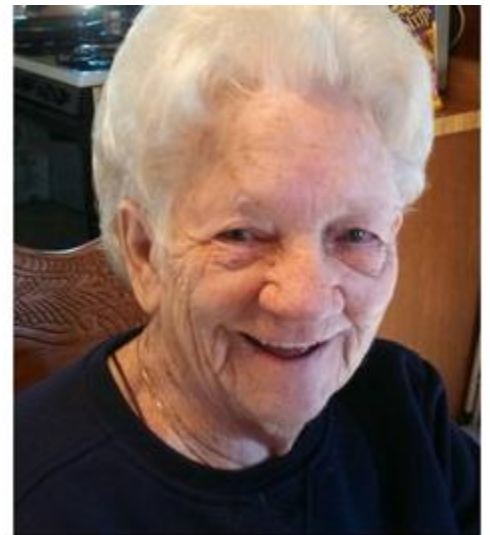
Mable Sitton
