KANE- Janet Lee Kallal, 75, died at 8:34 a.m., Wednesday, December 10, 2014 at Provision Living in Godfrey, after several years of declining health. She was born in Kane on Feb. 20, 1939, one of seven daughters born to Burl Walter & Violet Mae (Winters) Crawford. Janet graduated from Jersey Community High School, and attended the St. Joseph School of Nursing in Alton. She was employed as a Registered Nurse for 34 years at Jersey Community Hospital in Jerseyville prior to her retirement. She married William Joseph "Bill" Kallal on May 6, 1961 at the Holy Ghost Catholic Church in Jerseyville, and they shared 37 years together and were blessed with one daughter, before his death on June 4, 1998.
